She serves as a Subject Matter Expert, and is part of several teams that deliver a series of workshops to police executives on the development and improvement of Crime Analysis. Through a series of realistic lessons, analysts learn how to use the full potential of these programs for tactical, strategic, and administrative analysis.

Included are creating and querying databases with Access; statistics, charting, and data analysis with Excel; desktop publishing (crime bulletins and reports) with Word; and effective presentations with PowerPoint. This class is intended for the beginner or intermediate user.
